## GLENDALE SEEKS PUBLIC INPUT ON FIVE-YEAR PLAN

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** –Glendale will hold two public hearings on Thursday, Jan. 28 to gather input on writing a Five-Year Consolidated Plan. The first begins at 3:30 p.m. and is directed to non-profit agencies. The second is for residents and it begins at 6 p.m.

The Consolidated Plan will serve as a roadmap for spending decisions on federal funds used for public services, housing-related projects and facility improvements that benefit low-and-moderate income persons. Once completed, the plan will cover the time period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2015.

Annually, the Community Revitalization Division receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) program funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which support social and human services in Glendale.

Citizens and community groups are encouraged to attend these hearings at the City Municipal Office Complex, 5850 W. Glendale Ave, in Room B-3.
