SECTION 8 HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM

The Community Housing Division of the City of Glendale will accept applications for the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program on the following dates:

Tuesdays: **August 31, September 7, September 14 OR Thursdays: September 2, September 9, September 16.**

Applications will be taken only by telephone by calling (623) 930-2199 **between the hours of 8:30 a.m. & 12:00 p.m. only.** The waiting list will then be closed until further notice.

PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE HOUSING OFFICE. APPLICATIONS WILL ONLY BE TAKEN OVER THE TELEPHONE ON THE DATES AND TIMES INDICATED ABOVE.

Federal regulations require that all applicants and any household members over the age of sixteen are screened for past criminal histories.

Applicants and all household members must declare their U.S. citizenship status.

Applicants must qualify by earning no more than the following income limits based on family size:

Preferences are given for City of Glendale residents who are working or who are disabled or over the age of 62, active duty military personnel, homeless, displaced homemaker, victim of domestic violence, dating violence or stalking, and City of Glendale residents who are displaced by government action or natural disaster. Eligible applicants will be placed on a waiting list and notified when assistance is available. If you have any questions, please call 623-930-2180.

Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation, such as voice phone through AZ Relay TTY at 1-800-367-8939. Requests should be made early to allow time to arrange the accommodation.
