The Society can help:

- Active duty and retired Navy and Marine Corps personnel
- Eligible family members of the personnel listed above
- Eligible family members of Navy and Marine Corps personnel who died on active duty or in a retired status
- Reservists on extended active duty
- Indigent mothers (65 years or older) of deceased service members who have limited resources and no family to provide for their welfare
- Ex-spouses "20-20-20" former spouses (not remarried) whose marriage to a service member lasted for at least 20 years while the service member was on active duty
- Uniformed members of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)

The Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society can provide interest-free loans or grants to help with *emergency needs* such as:

- Emergency Transportation
- Funeral Expenses
- Medical/dental Bills (patient's share)
- Food, Rent, and Utilities
- Disaster Relief Assistance

- Unforeseen Family Emergencies
