Organization/Membership

- The GCBA is a 501(c)3 non-profit Arizona civic membership corporation, administered by a volunteer board of directors, selected by members
- Membership levels are to be determined by the board and membership committee. Membership dues (if any) will depend on need – based on other revenue services.
- In general, there will be five categories of members: 1) owner/landlord, 2) owner/operator, 3) tenant merchant, 4) Centerline area residents, and 5) support service providers.
- Opportunities are now open for volunteer positions on the board, membership recruitment teams and action committees. Your contributions are also needed to offset organizational and start-up costs while seeking out on-going revenue opportunities.

Newly organized as a 501(c)3 corporation, the Glendale Centerline Business Alliance has already achieved a great deal on behalf of Glendale's Centerline business community:

- Participated in Centerline briefings and organizational meetings
- Advocated for and earned a relaxation of the City's downtown signage regulations
- Called for and earned reinstatement of the plans to continue construction of the new City Court building
- Hosted a series of merchant socials to encourage camaraderie and to promote a "strength in numbers" philosophy

- Brought a “first year trial” farmers market to downtown, and are making plans for a larger, more aggressive market this year.
