Guidelines For Allowed Storage Items At Glendale Municipal Airport Hangars

In order to assist you and enable the upcoming hangar inspections to be conducted as efficiently as possible, a list of allowed storage items is provided below. Since all possible items cannot be listed, the basic rule from the 2004 Glendale Airport Rules and Regulations and FAA policy is that only aeronautical use items may be stored in aircraft storage hangars. A guideline of the allowed storage items is listed below:

1. All aircraft of record for your hangar storage space, including any aircraft that you own that are being restored
2. Aeronautical items associated with an aircraft in your hangar, including the parts, tools, equipment, and support items necessary to maintain and operate your aircraft
3. Prefabricated metal shelving, workbenches, and cabinets- the use of fire-resistant materials is preferred.
4. Motorized carts or bicycles used for transportation on the Airport
5. A reasonable amount of functional furniture, such as a table and chairs, only for use in the hangar
6. Spare aircraft tires and batteries; battery chargers stored in accordance with Fire Codes are allowed
7. Refrigerators, air conditioners, fans, and similar devices, as long as they are elevated 18" above the hangar floor and use no extension cords
8. Others storage items determined by the Airport Manager to be allowable, based on their function and the needs of the occupant

Aircraft hangars and any space within the hangar buildings may not be used for the storage of non-aeronautical items, such as boats, recreational vehicles, trailers, etc. The vehicle(s) used for transportation to and from the Airport may be parked in the hangar while the aircraft is in use. Additional vehicles may not be stored in the hangars.

The City of Glendale Fire Inspector and Building Safety Inspectors will be conducting inspections at the same time as the Airport's inspections.
