WHEREAS, April 11, 2010 marks the 42nd anniversary of the passage of the U. S. Fair Housing Law, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, by President Lyndon Johnson.

WHEREAS, this national policy allows for Fair Housing without regard to race, color, creed, national origin, sex, familial status, and handicap, and encourages fair housing opportunities for all citizens; and
